We guarantee that all bulls sold by Bowman Cattle are fertile to the best of our knowledge and have passed a breeding soundness exam prior to the sale. All bulls will be covered 50% by Bowman Cattle if they are injured during their first breeding season. Breeding season is defined as the 60-day period following the first turnout of the bulls. 50% of the value of the injured bull, minus salvage value will be given as credit in the following year's sale or toward a replacement bull if one is available. All injured bulls must be diagnosed by a veterinarian. Please notify us as soon as possible should injury occur and prior to the injured bull being sold for salvage. However, this is not a Life Insurance Policy.

**All claims must be made by September 1, 2019.**

We will do our best to select a bull that matches your specifications. Satisfaction is guaranteed or you don't own the bull.



### **Free Delivery and Trucking Discount**

Bulls sold to Colorado must be taken back to our ranch for current Trichomoniasis test before delivery. Free delivery to adjoining states. Bring your trailer sale day and receive \$75.00 off. Bulls will be delivered within one month of sale date unless other arrangements are made.

### **Retained Interest**

Bowman Cattle retains 1/3 revenue sharing interests in each bull selling. Buyer has 100% possession and 100% salvage value.

### **Herd Health**

All bulls selling have been fertility tested by Dr. Bill Shain of Bluffs Veterinary Clinic. Pap tested by Dr. Tim Holt.

### **Bull Development**

Bulls were weaned on hay and a protein pellet. They were then grazed on our hay fields until mid-March. From March until May they were fed the same ration as our replacement heifers designed to gain approximately 1 1/2 pounds per day. From May until mid-September bulls grazed in the hills between Albin and LaGrange, Wyoming. From mid-September to sale day bulls were fed a small gain and maintenance ration; primarily roughage with no corn added.

*No bull in this sale was assisted at birth or treated for enterotoxaemia or foot rot. All bulls Dams udder structure are sound, problem free and will last their lifetime. No bulls have ever been sold as yearlings or at any other time from this offering.*

### **Grazing Test Gain**

Bulls were weaned on grass hay and a protein pellet. They were then weighed and turned out on alfalfa and wheat regrowth on October 18, 2017. On February 18, 2018 bulls were weighed again, no supplement feed was fed.

### **Weaning Weights**

Bull calves were not creep fed.

### **Ultrasound Data**

All bulls were carcass ultra-sounded. Our scan data was taken right off of grazing test and bulls were pretty green. Typically, most bulls are scanned while on a good growing ration and in prime condition. Our data is hard to compare to other producer's programs. I listed exceptional ratios in the bulls' footnotes. Our scan data is reflected by their EPDs. If you would like more information please ask.

A popular calving ease bull we owned with Bull Barn Genetics. Raised in the Barstow program and used successfully in many large heifer breeding projects. He was our in-house heifer bull and was impressive in stature and progeny. We lost Cash Bar last spring, but we have an impressive offering of his progeny in this sale.

**Birth Weights**

By no means is this note meant to insinuate that our program is focused solely on birth weight. Every rancher has a comfort zone on birth weights, and we are no exception. In our program calving ease bulls are mainly used on heifers. Increasing birth weight moderately in mature cows has been proven to add many bonuses, including pay weight at weaning, and performance in the feedlot. Females retained are generally more rugged, exhibiting better fleshing abilities with larger pelvis scores. A true calving ease bull will be lighter boned, narrowly built, and flatter muscled, with smaller pelvis scores. This is not exactly the picture and traits we want our cow herd to possess. We use, and have used, extreme spread bulls (low birth weights/high growth). Spread bulls have mainly made our numbers on paper look better for you, but real weights on our scales have been disappointing. Females we retained exhibit less than desirable traits for true range conditions. In recent years, typical weaning weight EPDs ranged in the forties. Today you can find bulls with 70/90 weaning weight EPDs. Ask yourself, have your real weaning weights increased at the rate of the paper numbers? There are always exceptions in individuals, but in large contemporary groups the data becomes clear.

Millions of marginal mature cows are bred to continental breeds with known increased birth weights with very little assistance required. Many articles written in cattle papers fail to mention that crossbreeding programs designed around increased weaning weight and performance will add birth weight as well. We believe adding birth weight to Angus genetics will make them competitive with crossbred performance, if pounds are what you are seeking. The bonus is you will retain the angus calving ease, calf vigor, functional females, and the angus brand premiums we have grown to rely upon.

If you are experiencing calving problems or feel your mature cows can't birth 85 to 90 pound calves consistently, we strongly suggest you analyze the genetics you are injecting into your cow herd.

We acknowledge having an occasional glitch during calving, but know programs designed around extreme calving ease do as well.
